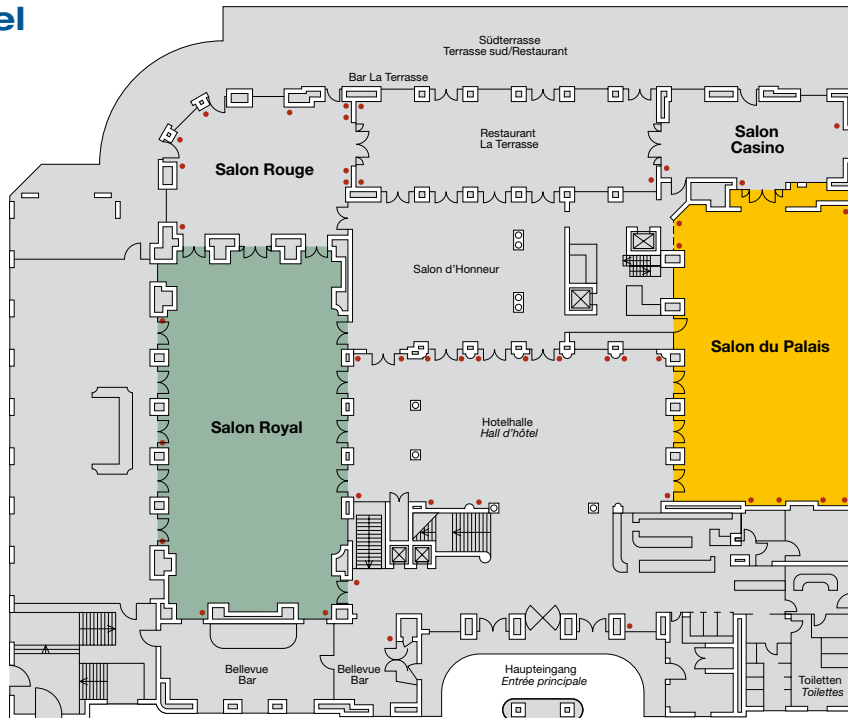

Ground level

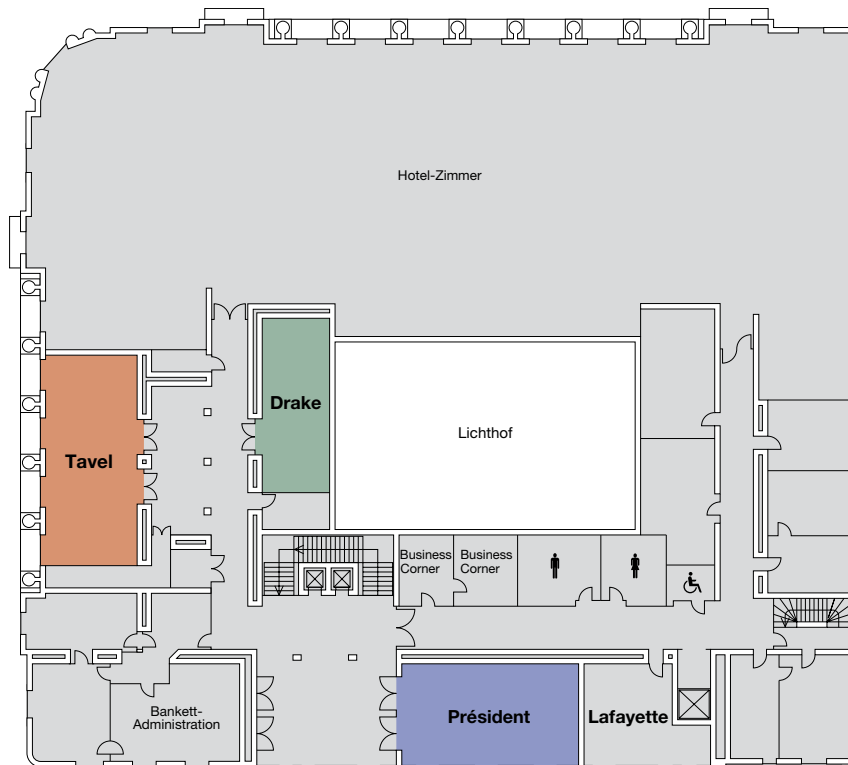

The official language of the congress will be English.

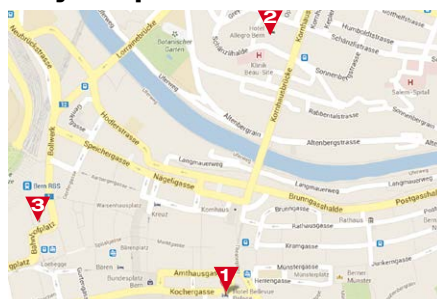
Emergency Services

Travel Information and Directions

By air:



Bern-Belp Airport: 20 min
Zurich Airport: 1 h 30 min
Basel Airport: 1 h
Geneva Airport: 1 h 30 min

Bern-Belp International Airport is the closest airport to Bern with daily connections to many European cities. The City of Bern is reachable within 20 minutes by public transport or by taxi.

By train:

The train brings you within 1 h 30 min from Zurich Airport to Bern (please check timetable by accessing www.sbb.ch).

From Bern train station to the hotel: tram no 7 or 8 (tram stop: «Zytglogge») or by taxi (about 2 min. drive). Walking distance train station to the hotel is about 5 min.
